### **Historical Note**

One of the oldest Polish Catholic congregations in Milwaukee, St. Hedwig's had its origins in the 1870 decision of St. Stanislaus Church parishioners to build a new church to serve the forty Polish families living on the East Side of the city. Work began the following year on the new church, which was constructed on three lots on the corner of Brady Street and Franklin Place, at a cost of \$11,000. The first Mass in the new building was celebrated on the feast day of St. Hedwig, October 17, 1871. A parochial school was established within a few years, and a men's groups, St. Adalbert Society, was organized February 1, 1874. During the following several years, a new school and rectory were built. In 1879 a women's organization, the Rosary Society, began holding meetings.

On March 5, 1886, the parish became a corporation, which immediately acted to construct a new church, the present building located at Brady and Racine Streets. Several new parish societies were established during the 1880's and 1890's, as the parish grew rapidly in size. Finally, in 1893 the parish was divided, and St. Casimir Congregation was formed to the north of St. Hedwig's. In 1896, 1921, and 1946, and 1971 St. Hedwig's celebrated its silver, golden, diamond, and centennial jubilees or anniversaries. Throughout the twentieth century, St. Hedwig's Church has maintained its vigor, modernizing its physical facilities and updating and renewing its programs and activities. In 2000 St. Hedwig, St. Rita and Holy Rosary merged to become Three Holy Women Parish.

### **Scope and Content** *a brief description of the types of materials in the collection.*

The collection mainly consists of parish records and records of several parish societies, with a scattering of miscellaneous items. Parish records include a recent, typewritten biography of the Church's patron saint, St. Hedwig, and several commemorative books and booklets published at the time of the parish's diamond jubilee and centennial anniversaries. Other records are primarily financial in nature, and include check stubs, a listing of donations, printed annual financial reports (sprawozania), and two journals of receipts and disbursements. Together the financial records span the period 1921-1959. Other parish records include printed weekly and biweekly church bulletins; a volume of Mass intentions, recording the disposition of large sums of money willed to the parish for Masses; and three volumes of sick call registers, which list the names and addresses of sick and dying prisoners, and record the names of the attending priests and what ministrations were given to the patient. A record similar to the volume of

Mass intentions is the Zlota Ksiazka Parafii Sw. Iadwigi, 1890, which lists the names of special donors to the Church.

Records of parish societies include two dues books, with members' names, dues paid, an annual financial summary, 1920-1959; and miscellaneous form letters of the Altar Society of St. Hedwig's. The volumes were donated by Anna Gruenwald, president of the Society in 1981. The Altar Society holds an annual meeting and breakfast, and conducts fund-raising rummage sales and raffles; the money is used to purchase furnishings and other articles for the sanctuary.

Records of the Civic and Athletic Association (formerly St. Hedwig Civil Club, and currently St. Hedwig Adults Dedicated to Youth) consist of a constitution, correspondence, financial and membership records, and minutes of the board of directors.

The Holy Name Society, a men's service and social organization, is represented by minutes of meetings, 1941-1955; membership and attendance lists; a cash book, 1949-1959; and fragmentary financial records and monthly reports

Records of the Rosary Society (occasionally listed in the records as Bractwo Rozanca Swietgo or Holy Rosary Confraternity; however the word Holy should not be listed in the correct English title) were presented by Ann Kuchta, vice-president of the Society in 1981. Included are two dues books, 1910-1935; a volume of attendance records, also listing annual dues payments; and a cash book, with members' names, dues, and attendance records.

St. Gabriel's Society of St. Hedwig's Church was organized July 1, 1921, to provide senior (adult) acolytes to serve at Masses. At one time, membership in the Society was sufficiently large to allow for six servers at each Sunday Mass; in the years prior to the Society's closing in 1979, membership and consequently, participation at services declined. The records include annual financial records of the Society, 1933-1952; documents regarding fund-raising events held by the Society such as bazaars and card parties; receipts; fragmentary correspondence; membership and officer's lists; and volumes recording dues, attendance, and receipts and disbursements, 1921-1956. The Society's minute books also record lists of members, schedules showing the assignment of members to various services, and financial summaries, 1921-1944. The records were donated by Roman Czarnecki, one of the last members of the organization.

Records of the Ushers' Society consist of minutes, 1940-1953, a cash book, 1943-1949, and miscellany. Other records of the Ushers' Society, and of other parish societies of St. Hedwig's, are located in the papers of Thaddeus Kucharski.

The records of the St. Vincent de Paul Society, organized February 3, 1914, are numerous and comprehensive. Included are volumes of minutes of meetings, 1914-1965, with treasures' reports; records of home visits made, relief given and aid funds paid, and information regarding the individuals and families involved; and quarterly and annual reports of Society work. More detailed records of home visits, often with correspondence and application forms, are present for many families during the 1930's and 1940's. In addition, there is a volume of membership and attendance records, 1923-1929; a folder of the rules of the Society; fragmentary correspondence; copies of the bulletin of the Milwaukee Metropolitan Central Council; and two sets of minutes of meetings of District No. 4 of the Society. Some of these records are restricted. There is also one folder of annual reports of the St. Vincent de Paul Society, 1914-1953, which are not restricted.

Other records in the collection include an undated, unsigned text of a sermon, a theology notebook apparently kept by a priest or seminarian, and a Polish language prayerbook, Chwalmy Pana.

A folder of photographs includes a photo of Church officials and priests, together with representatives of the religious community, and a choir or possibly a confirmation class, taken at the time of St. Hedwig's golden jubilee in 1921; a photo of the church dated May 18, 1933; two photos of Fr. Michael Wenta (pastor of St. Hedwig's from 1912-1935), one with his mother; St. Hedwig's choir (c. 1950), a photo of the dedication of the Church organ in 1949; and a group photo of St. Gabriel's Society members. Other photos have been retained in a collection at St. Hedwig's.
