

The following is the finding aid for the St. Pius X Guild collection located at the Archdiocese of Milwaukee Archives. Scope and Content *a brief description of the types of materials in the collection.*

St. Pius X Guild was created in 1951 in order to "promote the cause of sacred music in the Archdiocese." The collection reflects the activities of the Guild: minutes of meetings; church music workshops; programs of organ concerts; constitution of the Guild; newsletter/periodical "Gemshorn," 1961-1981. Also included are: newspaper clippings from music events sponsored by the Guild; organizational materials and correspondence concerning the Fifth International Church Music Congress, August 25-28, 1966, and the 1981 National Meeting of Diocesan Liturgical Commissions.
