Biographical Note

Fr. Daniel Garvey graduated from St. Francis Seminary and served as the pastor of St. Malachy Church in Horicon, WI and St. John the Baptist in Clyman, WI in the 1930s. In 1942, he was appointed pastor of St. Rose of Lima Parish in Racine, WI, where he remained until his death in 1983.

Scope and Content *a brief description of the types of materials in the collection.*

The collection consists primarily of record books from his time at St. Malachy in Horicon and St. John in Clyman. Also included is a letter he received from his younger brother when he was studying at St. Francis Seminary, a copy of his Will, and photographs of Garvey.
