# Papal Decree

of  
**Pope Gregory XVI,**  
in everlasting memory



**S**ince we have been placed at the head of the militant Church by God so willing it, and because we have the care of the Lord's universal flock, we ought to take steps to establish new dioceses throughout the world, according as the concern of events and times demands, in order that by appointing more shepherds the welfare of our Christian flock can be more properly and quickly taken care of.

**T**herefore, since at the Fifth Council of Baltimore, in May 1843, it was decided among other things to be also of universal importance that, to strengthen more firmly and advance more widely the Christian faith in the United States of North America, four new episcopal seats be erected, of which there be one set up at Milwaukee, the diocese of which embraces the territory of Wisconsin, we commissioned this subject of such great importance to be carefully considered by our venerable brother cardinals of the Holy Roman Church, with the endeavor being entrusted to the Propagation of the Faith. After mature deliberation therefore and with the advice of our same brothers we recognize the usefulness of the above mentioned establishment of the Milwaukee bishopric.

**W**ith this papal decree therefore and because of certain knowledge and out of the fulness of our apostolic power, with the force of this present letter we establish and make the new episcopal seat of Milwaukee, the diocese of which embraces the Wisconsin territory, and the title of which is derived from the city named Milwaukee.

**W**e resolve that this present letter is and will be firm, valid, and effective, and that it has and obtains complete and full effects and those to which it pertains and will pertain, and (we resolve) that this is fully approved for future times. Anything to the contrary notwithstanding.

Given in Rome at St. Peter's under the ring of the fisherman  
November 28, 1843, in the thirteenth year of our pontificate.
